MORNING PRAYER

Martin Luther's Morning Prayer

L: In the morning, as soon as you get out of bed, you are to make the sign of the holy cross and say:

C: Under the car of God the Father (+) Son, and Holy Spirit. Amen.

L: Then, kneeling or standing, say the Apostles' Creed and the Lord's Prayer.

C: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting Amen.

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day, our daily bread; and forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.

L: If you wish, you may recite this little prayer as well:

C. I give thanks to you, my heavenly Father, through Jesus Christ your dear Son, that you have protected me through the night from all harm and danger and I ask that you would also protect me today from sin and every danger, so that my life and actions may please you. Into your hands I commend myself: my body, my soul, and all that is mine. Let your holy angel be with me, so that the wicked foe has no power over me. Amen.

L: After singing a hymn, or whatever else may serve your devotion, you are to go to your work joyfully.

Sing: Praise God from whom all blessing flow;

Praise him, all creatures here below;

Praise him above, ye heavenly host;

Praise Father, Son and Holy Ghost.

MORNING PRAYER

L: The Psalmist once sang; "I offer my works to the King." We each need to offer ourselves to God at the beginning of every day.

C: It is worthwhile to work for a king.

L: A Spanish Saint once said; "I do not wish to work for a Lord who can die."

C: Serve the Immortal King of ages, the only one who deserves our total dedication.

L: Each morning before anything else, we offer our day to God.

C: I offer all the prayers, works, joys, and problems of this day to the Father, through the Son, my Lord and Brother, in union with the Holy Spirit. I unite myself in spirit and prayer with all Christians throughout the world. May the People of God witness the Good news of Christ in all places, at all times, today and forever. Amen.

L: O God, come to my assistance.

C: O Lord, make haste to help me. Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit; as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. Alleluia.

L: Lord, open our lips.

C: And our mouth shall proclaim your praise.

L: Nigh has passed to another day as we pray to the Lord of Lords.

C: That we may know peace of mind and body through His love and mercy.

L: To the beginning of this say you have brought us, O Lord God Almighty.

C: Preserve us now by your power so that today we may not fall into any sin.

L: We pray that all our words, thoughts and acts become part of your holy plan.

C: This we ask of You through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever.

L: Show us your mercy, O Lord.

C: And grant us your salvation.

L: Clothe your ministries with righteousness;

C: Let your people sing with joy.

L: Give peace, O Lord, in all the world;

C: For only in you can we live in safety. Amen.
